

YOUTH IN TRANSITION PROGRAM

Were you a **Crown Ward** or involved with Family and Children's Services before your 18th birthday? The Youth in Transition program can help qualifying youth connect with community services as they transition into adulthood. We can make referrals and set up supports around:

- Housing
- Education
- Employment Services
- Life Skills
- Money Management
- Health and Mental Health Services
- Legal Services
- Goal Setting and Reaching Youth Potential

We are available for **one-to-one interactions**, and can support in person, email, Facebook, phone or in a community setting. **Group Workshops** are also available. Please call for dates & times.

WHAT?

Youth in Transition is a free program offered by the YWCA St. Thomas-Elgin. This program is designed to provide supports to youth aged 16-24 inclusive, who are gaining independence and moving into adulthood, who have left or are leaving Family and Children Services Care.

WHO?

To be eligible for this program you need to be between the ages of 16-24, were/are a Crown Ward, or you were in a formal customary care agreement, immediately prior to your 18th birthday; OR: Were eligible to receive Renewed Youth Supports (RYS) at ages 16 or 17, regardless if you actually received RYS. To find out if you are eligible for these additional supports with the YWCA please connect with our Youth In Transition Worker.
